210. Introduction to Interdisciplinary Studies (3) F

This course provides an overview of the interdisciplinary studies program. It explores the history and philosophy of interdisciplinary studies, as well as the various fields and disciplines that contribute to the program. Students will engage in critical thinking and analysis of interdisciplinary research and practice. The course is designed to provide students with a solid foundation in the interdisciplinary studies program and to prepare them for more advanced coursework. The course is offered in the fall semester.

This course explores contemporary books and their impact on society. It examines the role of the author, the reader, and the book in the modern world. The course is designed to provide students with a deep understanding of contemporary literature and its cultural context. The course is offered in the spring semester.
