Program Delivery

The MSW Program accepts st dents as f ll-time or parttime st dents beginning in fall semester. St dents entering ith a degree other than the BSW m st complete 60 credit ho rs in t o or three ears to complete the program. Q ali ed applicants ith the BSW ma be eligible for the Ad anced Standing program, hich req ires 33 ho rs to complete the MSW in one ear f ll-time or t o ears part-time. Q ali cations incl de grad ation ith the BSW from a CSWE-accredited program, a GPA of at least 3.0, completed application, and references that meet the standards of the MSW Admissions Committee. (More information appears belo .) This degree is not offered in a totall online format; ho e er, depending on the content, both classroom and online options appear thro gho t the academic ear.

Graduate Program Admission Requirements

Admission to the program ill be based on competiti e selection from the pool of applicants ho meet the follo ing admission req irements:

- 1. Completion of a baccala reate degree from a regionall accredited college or ni ersit .
- 2. Of cial transcript(s) from all ndergrad ate and grad ate co rse ork attempted
- 3. Three letters of professional/academic reference specif ing the applicant's capabilities for grad ate st d .
- 4. Completed application, incl ding essa , ith application fee of \$25.
- 5. C m lati e GPA of at least 2.65 for the baccala reate degree.
- 6. A completed imm ni ation form.
- 7. An inter ie ith the Social Work Admissions Committee ma be req ested.
- 8. The follo ing personal q alities: Self-a areness, empath, objecti it, appreciation of di ersit, professional commitment, critical thinking abilit, effecti e oral and ritten comm nication skills, and the abilit to ad ocate for and empathi e for and ith others.

Program Options:

Full-time Program (Two years):

St dents ill complete 30 credit ho rs per ear, 15 credit ho rs each fall and spring semester. In addition each st dent ill complete 300 clock ho rs of, eld practic m in the, rst ear and 600 clock ho rs of, eld practic m in the second ear.

Part-time Program (Three years):

The part-time program req ires 9 credit ho rs in each fall and spring term. An additional 9 credits of electi es are req ired that can be taken in the Jan ar or s mmer terms.

Advanced Standing Program:

A st dent ith a B.S.W. degree from a CSWE-accredited ndergrad ate program ma appl for admission to the Ad anced Standing Program. Req irements for admission to Ad anced Standing incl de:

1. A minim m GPA of 3.0 in the ndergrad ate program.

2. At least a grade of B₂ in the Ad anced Standing

Provisional Admission

Applicants ho do not meet the reg lar admission req irements for the MSW program ma be admitted pro isionall at the discretion of the MSW Admissions Committee. Pro isional admission ill req ire contract al agreement bet een the applicant and the Admissions Committee to specif the conditions that m st be met to matric late into the MSW program itho t the designation of pro isional stat s.

Transfer of Credit

Grad ate credit for corses earned at a regionall accredited ni ersit and in a CSWE-accredited MSW program mabe transferred to Union Uni ersit if the corses are essentiall

The ma im m n mber of semester ho rs that ma be transferred to Union Uni ersit and applied to the MSW degree is nine ho rs, nless e ten ating circ mstances are presented s ch as to req ire special fac lt appro al other ise.

No corrse ith a grade less than B ma be transferred. Corrses taken more than e ears before beginning the MSW program ill be considered on an indi id al basis.

Financial Assistance

Federal Stafford Loans

St dents enrolled in the Master of Social Work program for a minim m of si ho rs per semester, fall or spring, ma appl for the Federal Stafford Loan. The Stafford loan application process ill req ire that o :
