Students who have **not** fulfilled the immunization requirements **will not be permitted to move on campus** until it has been verified by Health Services that the appropriate documentation is received.

To ensure compliance with the above policy, Health Services will also place a "Health Hold" on a student's account. A student with a "Health Hold" **will not** be able to register for or drop classes until the appropriate documentation is received. Any variation of these requirements will be determined by the Director for Health Services.
